BOD Reports

- Vice President – The 2009 Sun Valley Open is looking for sponsorship, and we should see what we would be willing to do to help. Additionally, we are looking into having a sanctioned event at Bayside in the first week of October.
- Treasurer – Has gotten together with Pres. Jeff and has ironed out 1024 forms (non-profit). It provides us a green light to pursue our non-profit status.

Course Rep. Reports

- Morley Field – Members would like to see more tournament activity, and would like to see more BBQ/Clinic events at Morley in the near future.
- Sun Valley – No Report.
- Emerald Isle – Randy still needs to follow up on disc golf rules sign in Emerald Isle pro shop (see may minutes for details) and plans to do so
- Montiel – Continues to have a high level of play. Montiel Park bag tags are on sale for \$5, money goes to San Marcos July 4th Fireworks fund. Needs to run the WBDGW event as soon as possible. There will be the second annual installment of the Montiel Ace Race sometime from August-October.

Monica Watkins, Head Fundraiser for CSUSM project – Monica has a detailed plan of exactly how much all installations for the course will cost and believes that she needs to raise funds of at least \$16,000 for the full installation of an 18 hole course on the campus of California State University San Marcos. She has already received verbal commitments for donations towards the project totaling approximately \$8000, and has set a goal of raising all necessary funds by October 5th.

Patrick Paramore, discussing San Diego Summer Tour – Wants to have a multi-course tournament this summer and wants the aces to get involved.

New Business

- The Aces passed a motion to sponsor a tee sign for \$30 (minimum, but not limited to) and additional prizes for the 2009 Sun Valley Open.
